ORDER OF RULEMAKING

11 CSR 70-2.010 Definitions. The Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control is amending section (24) and adding new section (30).

PURPOSE: This amendment clarifies the division’s longstanding practice of treating legal entities the same way corporations are treated in evaluating their qualifications for licensure and permanently codifies previous emergency regulation. Further, the division wanted to simplify the definition of “two (2) cases of wine” as it is used in § 311.185, as it has caused confusion in recent litigation.

(24) *[A case of wine, for the purposes of wine direct shipments, is a box, crate, or other container that holds twelve (12) standard bottles of wine in the manufacturer’s original package, each containing seven hundred fifty milliliters (750 ml), or holds one (1) or more containers of wine in the manufacturer’s original package with an aggregate total of no more than nine (9) liters or two and thirty-eight hundredths (2.38) gallons of wine.]* **Two (2) cases of wine, as it is referred to in § 311.185, RSMo, shall mean the equivalent volume of four and seventy-six hundredths (4.76) gallons shipped in a calendar month.**

(30) Association, as it is used in § 311.030, RSMo, includes limited liability companies and all business entities not otherwise described in Chapter 311, RSMo, as a person.
