## **PUBLIC ADVISORY 24-01**

### ***Executive Order 24-10, Prohibiting Sale of Unregulated Psychoactive Cannabis Products in Missouri***

On August 1, 2024, Governor Parson issued [Executive Order 24-10](#) which addresses unregulated psychoactive cannabis products and the ban against such products being sold as food products, or used as food additives, and the sale of such products at retail liquor-licensed establishments.

The Department of Health and Senior Services has regulatory authority over the prohibition of unregulated psychoactive cannabis products being sold as food products, or used as food additives. As such, they have created a website ([Unregulated Psychoactive Cannabis Products | Food Safety | Health & Senior Services \(mo.gov\)](#)) where additional information can be found. Additionally, retail establishments known or suspected to be selling such products can be reported anonymously at this site.

Any enforcement will not commence until September 1, 2024. The Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control will be pursuing regulatory amendments as directed by the Executive Order. Those amendments will be posted on our website ([Regulations and Statutes | ATC \(mo.gov\)](#)) under the applicable Amended Rules, Emergency Rules and Proposed Rules section(s).
